Dedicated in 2001 as Gerry's House, we are named for Gerry Haff,

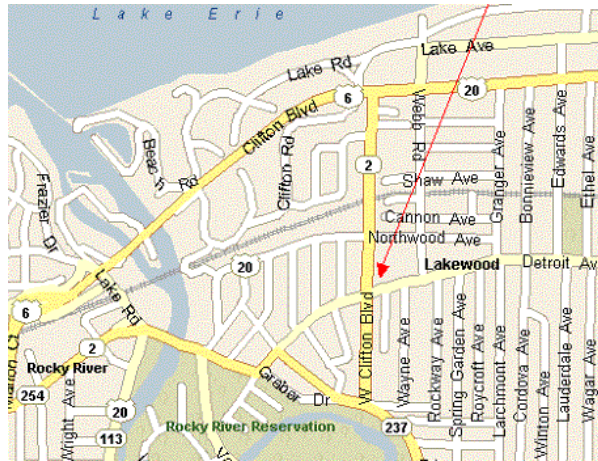
longtime WRA Christian Educator, mentor, teacher, friend, visionary of resource ministry, and the first director of the Western Reserve Association Resource Center.

- **Justice LED** - Justice Leaders Engaging and Developing (Justice LED) is a curriculum and program offered by UCC Justice and Witness Ministries. It is an innovative curriculum that includes interactive scripture study, engaging video resources, and guided reflection and dialogue for groups.

Online Database of Resources – Before the end of the year, the resource center will have all our resources listed for online referencing. By typing in this link:

you will be connected to a page that allows you to look at many "collections" of resource materials. By clicking on one of the collections you will be taken to a page that will show you all the materials in that collection of resources. If you click on one of the books in the collection you will have all the information (and usually a picture of the resource) for you to review. There are even places for people to leave comments and read others comments about that resource.

You do not have to join "Library Thing" (who is the host site for our online listing) to view our materials. You will need to join "library thing" to leave comments. Joining is free and a really simple process. Again, you do not need to join anything to look through the Gerry's House Resource Center listing of resources!

Resources can be picked up at Gerry's House 1375 West Clifton Blvd - Lakewood, Ohio 44109 (we are located on the 2nd floor at Lakewood Congregational UCC).
